



How to download EBSCO eBooks

Comprehensive tutorial for the first-time downloading following the process step-by-step.

eBooks collections provide you with a possibility to search them within familiar interface of EBSCOhost altogether with other databases. You can read eBooks right on the Internet or download them into your computer or other mobile devices to read them without Internet connection later on. Since regular documents within EBSCOhost can be copied or printed out eBooks are equipped with this feature as well...what are the requirements for downloading EBSCO eBooks:

- **Adobe® Digital Editions** 1.7.1 (or its any newer version) – freeware application
- Personal folder **My EBSCOhost** (free-of-charge)
- **AdobeID** (one-time authorization of Adobe Digital Editions)

Searching and downloading eBooks

1. Find the desired eBook on the EBSCOhost platform.
2. For downloading eBook title click on the link **Download (Offline)** with left mouse button.

4. As soon as you log in the system will automatically offer the possibility to download the eBooks. You can also choose the checkout duration (how long the eBook title will be available for your offline reading).

What is Digital Editions?

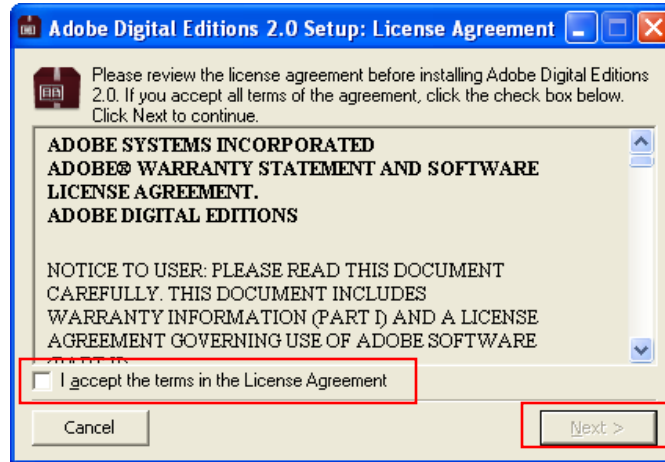
Adobe® Digital Editions software offers an engaging way to view and manage eBooks and other digital publications. Use it to download and purchase digital content, which can be read both online and offline. Transfer copy-protected eBooks from your personal computer to other computer or devices. Organize your eBooks into a custom library and annotate pages. Digital

- I. In the new window that has opened up click with left mouse button on the link **Download Now** near to the upper right corner. There will appear a new window from which you can select the file according to the operation system of your computer (Windows / MacOS).



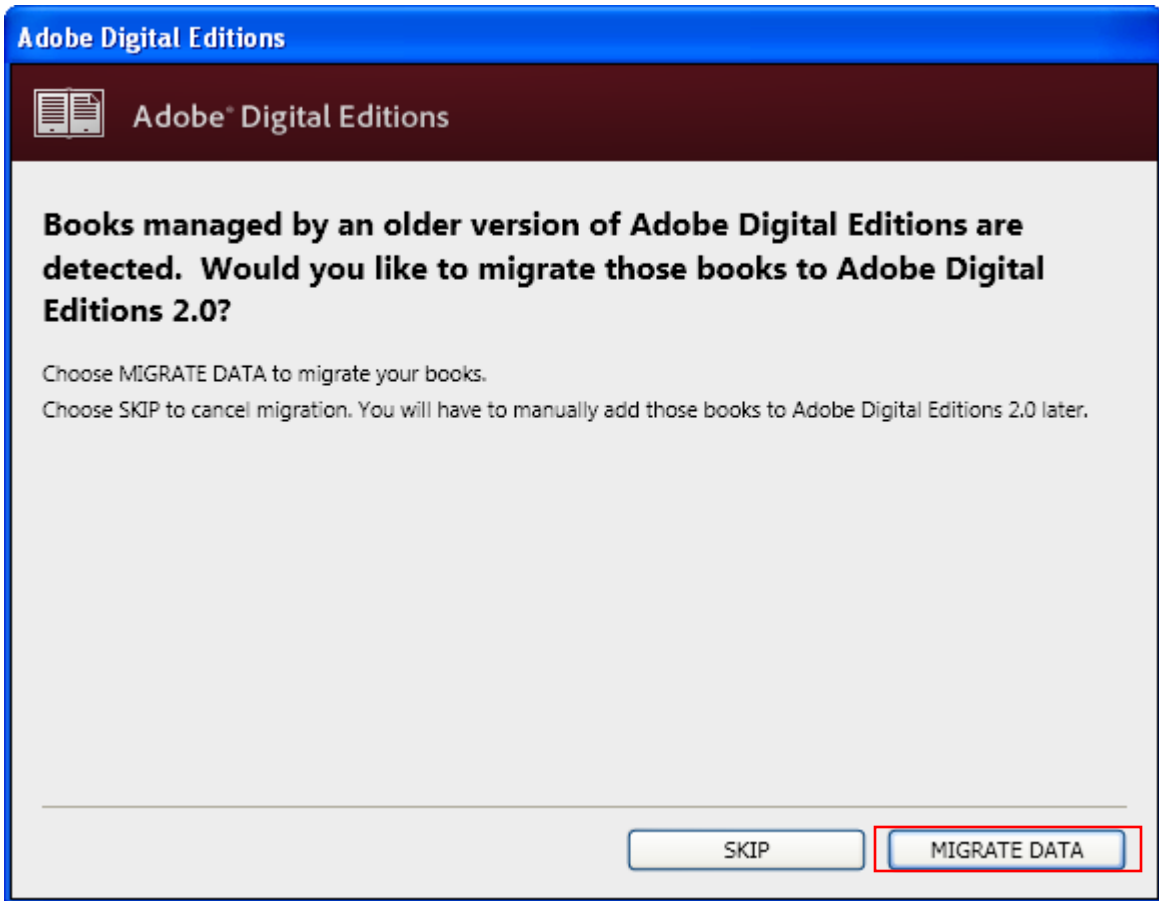

- II. A new window will open up from which you can simply select which type of operation system you are going to install the application on (Windows or Apple). When you choose the system, the computer will automatically start downloading the installation file or you will be offered to download it (depending on type of internet browser you are using).
- III. Install the application.

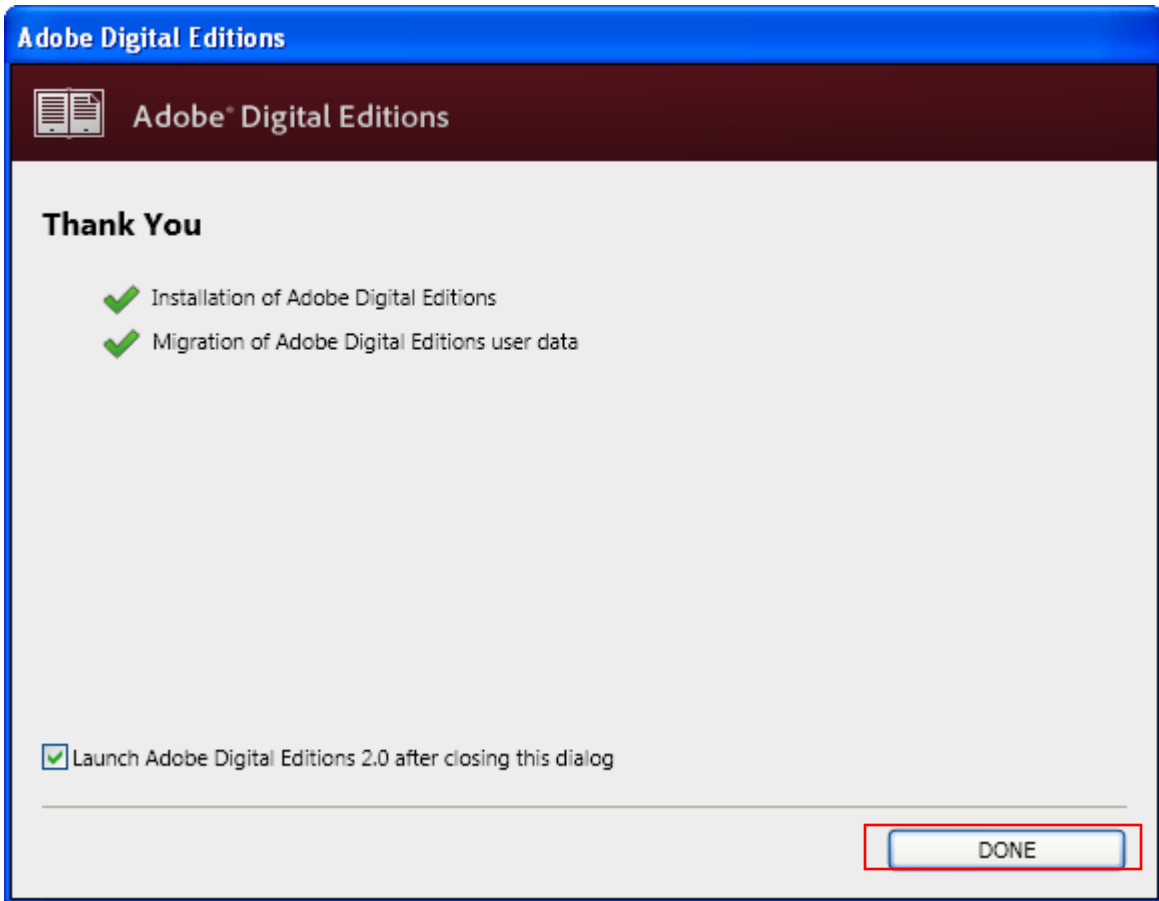


In case you have already used Adobe Digital Editions on this computer in the past, it is possible that the previously downloaded eBooks will be imported. If you are installing this application for the first time, please skip following two steps.

- iv. When launching the application first time, Adobe Digital Editions will offer the possibility to import eBooks into the interface. If you wish to do so, confirm clicking on the button **Migrate Data**. eBooks will be imported automatically then.



- v. Installation and migration of data into Adobe Digital Editions has been successfully finished and the program is ready for use.



Downloading eBook

6. As we have finished installation of the Adobe Digital Edition, we can proceed to downloading the eBook into your computer. Switch back into your internet browser and the screen of EBSCOhost when we stopped when checking out (borrowing) the eBook. When confirmed downloading the eBook by clicking on the button **Checkout & Download** system will offer you a possibility to download a file with an extension *.acsm. Download it.

7. After downloading open the file. In case you have Adobe Digital Editions installed and properly associated (default setting) with these files, the application will automatically turn on and try to import the eBook from the server.



8. In case you have not authorized the computer via Adobe Digital Editions yet, you will be prompted to do so using AdobeID. Here you only need to input your login credentials (if you have them) or to choose the option to create a new account. To create a new account, click on the button „**Create an Adobe ID**“ (AdobeID account is free-of-charge).

Please note: In case you already have your Adobe Digital Editions authorized, then please skip the steps 8-10.

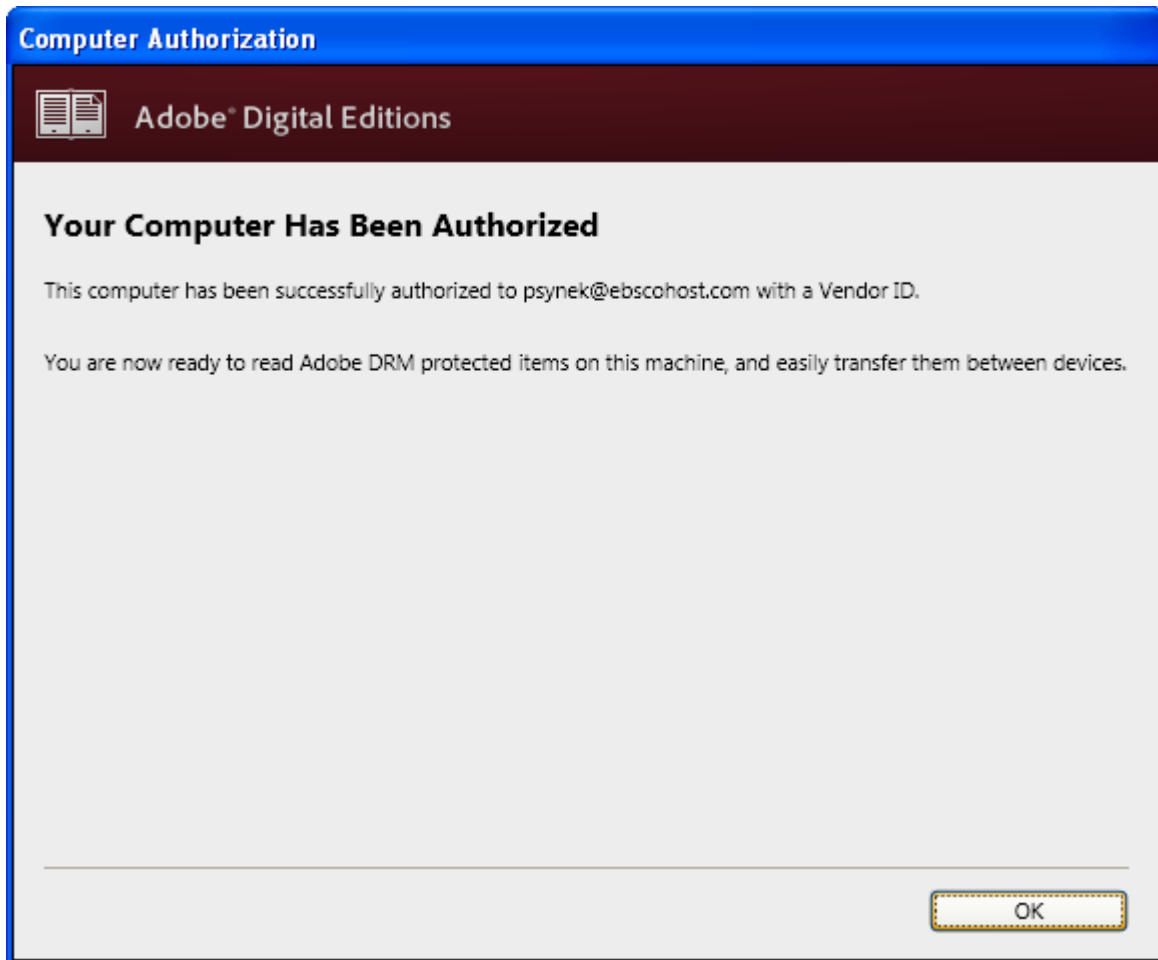

10. After creating AdobeID we can switch back into the Adobe Digital Editions and use the login credentials we have just created. After submitting we will see a note of confirmation that the computer is now authorized for downloading eBooks.



- As soon as we authorize the computer eBook download will start automatically.
