

Introducing the multilingual digital platform for the Conference on the Future of Europe



This is the central hub and interactive tool of the Conference on the Future of Europe. Here, **you can share your ideas, find events**, read input from **all Conference events**, and **follow the progress** of the Conference. And this will be possible in the 24 official EU languages.



You can connect, develop ideas together with other people and have your say on the future of Europe. All contributions to the Conference will be brought together and shared, including from citizens' contributions, local events, European citizens' panels and Conference Plenaries.



The platform is organised around key topics for debate and deliberation (climate change and the environment; health; a stronger economy, social justice and jobs; EU in the world; values and rights, rule of law, security; digital transformation; European democracy; migration; and education, culture, youth and sport). These topics are complemented by an 'open box' for you to contribute ideas on additional issues that matter to you.

Through the platform you can:

Share own ideas, and endorse or comment on those of others, in any chosen language. This will create a truly transnational debate directly between citizens across Europe.

Access a map of (digital, hybrid or physical) events and sign up to participate.



Upload information about own events organised – adhering to the key principles of the Conference, and sharing outcomes on the platform after, in order to open the debate to a wider audience.

What is the platform's role within the Conference

The online multilingual digital platform aims to maximise participation, foster a truly European discussion between citizens, and ensure both the accessibility and transparency of the Conference on the Future of Europe.

It is open to all **citizens**, **public actors** (EU institutions, national Parliaments, local authorities etc.) and **civil society**, whether pan-European or national/local. **As diverse and as many people as possible are encouraged to take part.** It will fully respect users' privacy, and EU data protection rules.

The platform facilitates the **bottom-up**, **citizens-driven exercise and public access to all event outcomes**. It will **ensure that the discussions held all over the EU are heard** by decision-makers in EU institutions.

How to access the platform

Anyone can read and browse the ideas and events on the platform, but registration is needed in order to contribute (ideas or events). Users register via the "EU Login" system or they can log in via social media.
